HIGHWAY 93 PROJECTS

Evarto McClure Road:

M.A. DeAtley is just doing some clean up on this project. Everything is pretty much wrapped up but the chip seal in June or July. Project Completion is scheduled for July.

McClure Rd – North Arlee:

Pretty much all that is left is the chip seal and final striping and they are saying that won't happen until June or July.

ON GOING PROJECTS

Polson Professional Bldg:

This project is complete and staff are beginning the big move into the new building.

Mission Dam Road Bridge:

Fryberger Construction will be wrapped up this week.

8 km S of Polson – South:

MA DeAtley Construction is currently shut down until June 1st. They hope to commence with irrigation work and rock excavation. This will be followed by 627 scraper excavation and trucking of special borrow and crushed aggregate course. Project completion is scheduled for late August. Final seeding will be done in October to finish up the project.

Lonepine NE – MT 28:

SK Construction is going great guns over there. They are using a lot of side dumps and scrapers. There hasn't been a lot of hiring yet other than scrapers, side dumps and dozers. For those of you interested in working with SK you will need to come to our office and fill out their application.

Certification Class

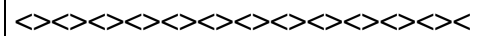
This is scheduled for May 10th & 11th in Pablo. You will need to come by the Indian Preference Office for an eligibility application that will need to be submitted prior to the

class. **To be eligible you must meet the following criteria:**

1. annual income below 185% poverty level. Example: family of 4 have to make less than \$40,793.
2. Have a minor child in the home.
3. Currently NOT receiving TANF
4. Must complete eligibility application with the following attached: family size, income, citizenship and identity verification. (this could be birth certs, enrollment cards, DL's, tax return, pay stubs)
