## ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CONFEDERATED SALISH AND KOOTENAI TRIBES OF THE FLATHEAD RESERVATION, MONTANA

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CONFEDERATED SALISH AND KOOTENAI TRIBES THAT AMENDMENT NO. 25 SHALL AMEND ORDINANCE 103-A AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Section 3-3-404. Status Offenses. This section is added as follows:
- (1) Youths under the age of 18 may be cited for Status Offenses. Status Offenses shall be referred to Youth Court I or Youth Court II pursuant to Section 3-3-102(34) and 3-3-102(35) for disposition.
- 2) Section 3-3-405. Curfew Violation. This section is added as follows:
- (1) Every person under the age of 18 is subject to curfew times as follows:
- (a) 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. the following morning Sunday through Thursday, and;
- (b) 12:00 midnight until 6:00 a.m. the following morning on Friday and Saturday.
- (2) Youths may be cited for Curfew Violation notwithstanding any violation of Section 2-1-710, CSKT Laws Codified.
- 3) Section 3-3-406. Runaway. This section is added as follows:
- (1) A person under the age of 18 commits the offense of Runaway as follows:
- (a) Leaving a Court Ordered placement without authority to do so:
- (b) Leaving home without the consent of a parent or guardian or a custodian having legal custody of the youth and being reported by the parent/guardian/custodian as having run away.
- 4) Section 3-3-407. Truancy. This section is added as follows:
- (1) A person under the age of 16 commits the offense of Truancy by being subject to compulsory school attendance, is absent from school without prior approval of a parent or guardian.

## CERTIFICATION

The foregoing Amendment No. 25 to Ordinance 103-A was adopted by the Tribal Council on July 14, 2009, with a vote of 7 for; 0 opposed; and 0 not voting, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a), (l), (n), (q), (r) and (u) of the Tribes' Constitution and Bylaws; said Constitution adopted and approved under Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984), as amended.
